I know how to say sound for each letter in the alphabet and at least 10 digraphs

I know how to read aloud simple sentence and books that are consistent with their phonic knowledge, including some common exception words.

I know how to re-read books to build up confidence in word reading, fluency and understanding and enjoyment.

I know how to write recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed.

I can begin to write simple sentences that match my phonic knowledge.

I can write some irregular common words. (RWI red words)
